

Oral Presentation Guidelines

 - **Presentation language:** English
 - **Presentation must be submitted before:** **February 28, 2018 (GMT+8)**
 - **File format:**
 1. Please make sure that your files are submitted in **4x3 Microsoft Office PowerPoint format**. Images may be distorted in other presentation formats.
 2. Presentations that are submitted in Keynote format will NOT be allowed.
 3. Each e-poster presentation document should **NOT** exceed 22 slides (including cover and reference page.)
 4. Animations, video clips, sound, or any other item different from the presentation format should be embedded in the presentation file and reviewed before presenting.
 - **File size:** The maximum file size allowed is **20MB**.
 - **Labelling file:** Please label your file as follows and do not include symbols such as (),/~' as this will prevent your presentation from being properly stored in Meeting Room computers:
- Session Name
 - Presentation Order (As noted in the Oral Presentation Submission Reminder)
 - Your Name
 - Abstract Title
- For Example: *Advanced Brain MR Imaging_1_John Smith_Abstract Title*

- Presenters must disclose the potential financial conflicts in the materials or the studies they present.
